

Unbroken (Part 2): The Covenant God Never Canceled

SERMON OUTLINE

Introduction:

- Israel is not a side issue — it's a central thread running through the heart of our faith.
- When you tug on the thread of Israel, you pull every thread — history, theology, justice, the very return of Jesus.
- Last week, we considered why we must challenge Replacement Theology.
- This week, we'll be looking at why Christians must support Israel.

The People and Land Were Established by God

Genesis 12:1-3; Genesis 15:18-21; Deuteronomy 1:8

The God We Serve is the God of Israel

Joshua 7:13; Judges 6:8; 1 Samuel 10:18; 2 Chronicles 6:14-17; 1 Kings 8:22-26; Malachi 3:6

- He is not the God of confusion. He is not the God of abandonment. He is the God of Israel! And the God of Israel does not change.

Jesus is the Jewish Messiah

- Fulfillment of prophecies (Genesis 49:10; Isaiah 11:1-3)
- Born, circumcised, and raised as a Jew (Luke 2:4, 21-22)
- Preached in synagogues (Luke 4:14-16)
- Lion of Judah (Revelation 5:4-5)
- Jesus wasn't born in Rome. Jesus wasn't born in Athens. He was born in Bethlehem of Judea. Circumcised under the Law of Moses, taught in the synagogues — He is the Lion of the tribe of Judah.

Jesus is Returning to Israel

Zechariah 14:4-9

- "And when He comes again — He's not coming back to Washington, Paris, or Mecca. He's coming back to Jerusalem — to the Mount of Olives — to reign as King of all the earth!"

Conclusion:

- God will use the Church to point Israel to the Messiah. (Romans 11:12, 25-27)
- The Church's destiny is tied to Israel's destiny. Their redemption is our rejoicing. Their restoration is a sign of the soon return of our King.

Closing Declaration

- We bless Israel. We pray for the peace of Jerusalem. We align with God's heart, God's promises, and God's coming Kingdom.
